So lean into God the Father and let him go before you and make your way smooth. Trust him to handle every detail and every person.

Tip of the week:

Help your new students feel comfortable and confident in the class by being organized and ready to lead each week. This means being very familiar with both the Leader's Guide and, if you are also the facilitator of the class, the Class Facilitator's Manual. Go over the lists, announcements, and forms needed and be very prepared. When you are reading the Statement of Understanding, stress the importance of confidentiality and communicate your desire that everyone would find this class to be a safe place. And remember to always get the money as soon as they say they want to take the class! Offering the 2-week, money-back guarantee works like a charm.
